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


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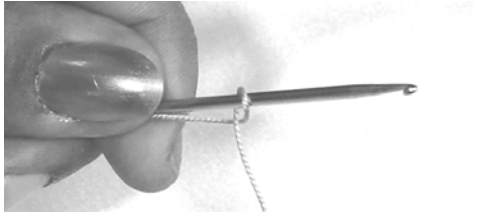
# Crochet Tatted Lace Basics

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## Left Handed Instructions

### Lesson 1

<b>The Double Stitch:</b>	
	<b>Fig 01:</b> Secure thread in right hand holding thread end against hook with left hand. Working anti-clockwise (from right to left)
	<b>Fig 02:</b> Wrap all the way around finger back to beginning; make sure thread is crossed
	<b>Fig 03:</b> Make a fist, place hook under thread of loop formed on index finger



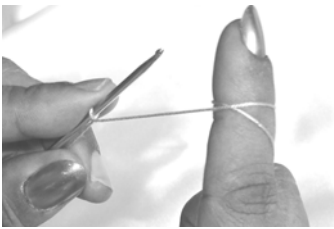
**Fig 04:** Slide thread off finger onto hook



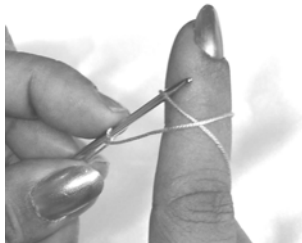
**Fig 05:** Pull thread snug on hook



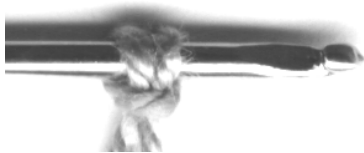
**Fig 06:** Secure thread in Right hand  
between index and middle finger



**Fig 07:** Wrap thread around index finger of Right  
hand, in a clockwise direction (from left to right)



**Fig 08:** Make sure thread is crossed place hook  
under thread,



**Fig 09:** Slide thread off finger onto hook Pull  
thread so stitch fits snug on hook.

**The Picot (p)**



**Fig 10:** Make first half of ds don't slide st next to last ds made, leave a space of a quarter inch



**Fig 11:** Make second half of ds. Slide ds next to previous ds made.
