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


<p style="text-align: center;">Close Ring</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Fig 12: Make (8 ds, p, 8 ds)</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Fig 13: Pass ball thread over the back of right hand, place right thumb on ball thread in front of hook, yo</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">Fig 14: With hook facing down hold stitches between index and thumb finger of right hand, pull through all loops on hook</p>




Fig 15: Insert hook in loop at other end of work.
(You now have two loops on hook)




Fig 16: Without removing hook from loops lift
hook pulling on inside loop




Fig 17: Pull on ball thread to tighten enlarged
