






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Crochet Tatted Lace Basics

Right Handed Instructions
Lesson 1

<p>The Double Stitch:</p> 	<p>Fig 01: Secure thread in left hand holding thread end against hook with right hand. Working clockwise (from left to right).</p>
	<p>Fig 02: Wrap all the way around finger back to beginning; make sure thread is crossed</p>
	<p>Fig 03: Make a fist, place hook under thread of loop formed on index finger</p>

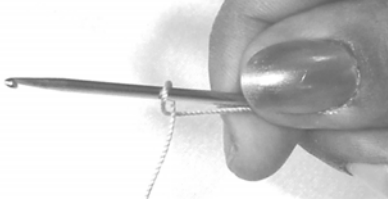


Fig 04: Slide thread off finger onto hook



Fig 05: Pull thread snug on hook

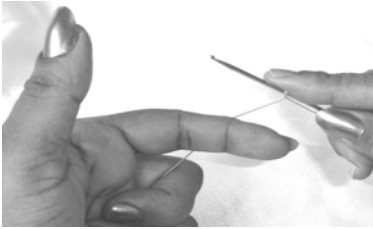


Fig 06: Secure thread in left hand between index and middle finger

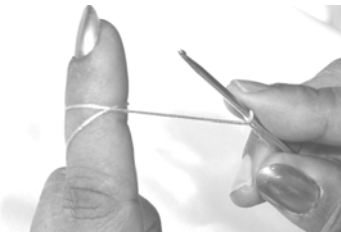


Fig 07: Wrap thread around index finger of left hand in an anti-clockwise direction (from right to left),

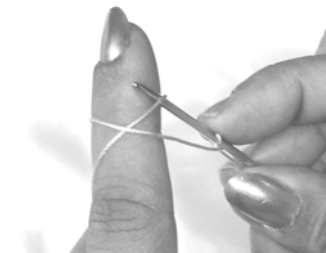


Fig 08: Make sure thread is crossed Place hook under thread



Fig 09: Slide thread off finger onto hook, pull thread so stitch fits snug on hook

The Picot (p)



Fig 10: Make first half of ds don't slide st next to last ds made, leave a space of a quarter inch.



Fig 11: Make second half of ds. Slide ds next to previous ds made. **Picot is formed**
