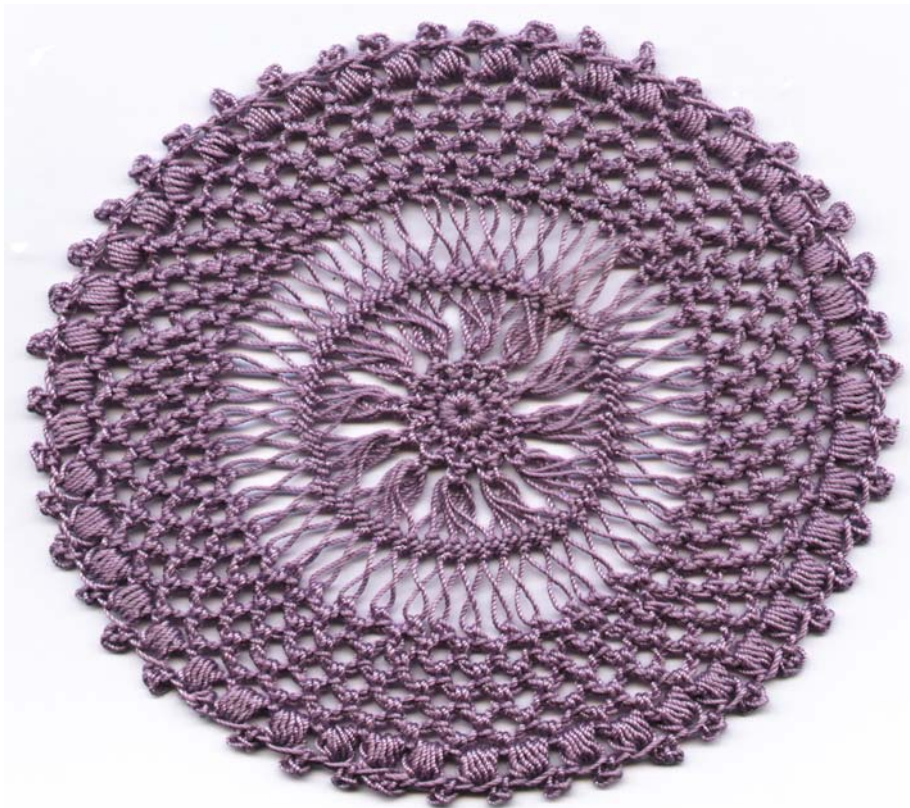

Materials you will need

For thread:

Hairpin Lace loom

Tapestry needle

Size # 6 steel crochet hook

1 ball of size 10 thread

For Yarn

NB: Use recommended hook for yarn you're using

Instructions

Hairpin Lace: set prongs 1 inch apart for thread and one and a half to two inches apart for yarn depending of size yarn used. Follow how to instructions to make hairpin lace. Each side of lace should have 48 loops.

Rnd 01: Ch 5 sl st in first ch st to form ring, ch 1, 12 sc in ch 5 sp, sl st in first sc

Rnd 02: Ch 1, sc in join, ch 1 sc in first 4 loops on inside edge of hairpin lace *(Ch 1, sc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next 4 loops of hairpin lace) around, ch 1 sc in first sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Rnd 03: Working on outer edge of hairpin lace. Attach thread to any loop of hairpin lace, ch 1 sc in same loop, *(ch 2, sc in next loop) around, ch 1, sc, in first sc.

Rnd 04: Ch 1, sc in join, *(ch 3, sc in next ch 2 sp) around, ch 1, hdc in first sc.

Rnd 05 to 08: Ch 1, sc in join, *(ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp) around, ch 1, hdc in first sc.

Rnd 09: Ch 1, *[(yo insert hook in ch 3 sp, yo and pull up) 5 times, yo and pull through all loops on hook, (puff st), ch 4, sl st in first ch st] around, sl st in first puff st. Fasten off
